### **Toll Holdings to Reduce Greenhouse Gases**

Toll Holdings, Australia's leading provider of integrated transport and logistics services is taking care of the environment as well as its clients as a result of its five-year greenhouse action plan. Toll is committed to emission reduction as a member of the national greenhouse gas abatement program - Greenhouse Challenge Plus.

Launched in 2005, Greenhouse Challenge Plus involves a partnership between Australian government, business and industry to reduce emissions.

Toll's Managing Director, Paul Little said that Toll will be cutting energy consumption and reducing waste levels under the Greenhouse Challenge Plus action plan.

"The Plan is expected to result in significantly reducing Toll's vehicle emissions between 2006 and 2009 and beyond, creating major reductions in our costs and overall energy bill," Mr Little said.

The Transport Industry is amongst one of the most energy intensive industries in Australia, providing services 24 hours a day, seven days a week. In addition to the high requirements of fuel for vehicles, there is a high requirement of fuel for heating and cooling.

"We believe all Toll businesses have a responsibility to assist our environment and find ways to reduce greenhouse gas emissions," Mr Little continued.

"Undertaking good environmental practice is an integral part of responsible management of the company."

Toll will undertake a Cooperative Agreement with the Australian Government committing to reduce their emissions through a detailed greenhouse action plan.

The Agreement typically includes an inventory of emission levels, specific actions to reduce emissions and a commitment to report progress to the Australian Government every year.

Actions can include reducing energy consumption and cutting waste, through to switching to renewable energies, using alternative fuels and changing organisational culture so that staff supports greenhouse abatement actions.



Toll's Greenhouse Challenge Plus plan will be driven by Toll Facilities Management, a key supplier of strategic asset management solutions for Toll, ensuring maximum long-term energy reduction initiatives are achieved by business and industry.

Toll is looking forward to playing a part in Australia's efforts to reduce greenhouse gases.

We hope we can set an example for other transport companies to join Greenhouse Challenge Plus and further expand Australia's greenhouse action.
